

Emergency Preparedness Supply Kit

Store these items in a container that is easy to identify and carry:

- Water for drinking & cooking, plan on 1 gallon per person per day. Store water in sealed, unbreakable containers
- Non-perishable packaged or canned food (3 day supply). Have a manual can opener and bottle opener
- Baby food
- Paper plates & utensils
- Candles and matches (keep in water proof container)
- Infants and children needs such as diapers, books, games, cards, toys
- Elderly or disabled family members needs such as hearing aid batteries, medical information
- Know the style and serial number of medical devices, such as pacemakers
- Have an extra set of car keys
- Have credit cards and cash and or travelers checks in a water proof container
- One blanket for each person
- Change of clothing, include rain gear and sturdy shoes
- Gloves, coat, socks, shoes appropriate for weather conditions
- Toilet articles and personal hygiene needs
- Battery powered radio, flashlight and plenty of extra batteries
- First aid kit, include prescription medications
- Extra pair of eyeglasses and or contact lenses
- Have photographs or videos of your personal property. Include serial numbers when possible
- An axe, shovel and any other tools you may need
- Also have copies of your insurance policies and copies of other important documents in water proof containers
- Records of your pet's vaccination record (copies)
- Pet carrier
- State Road Map with Evacuation map in your car
- National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Weather Radio & extra batteries
- Oil or kerosene lantern (flashlights are safest)
- Flashlights and batteries
- Duct tape
- Garbage bags w/ties
- Cotton t-shirt or mask
- Wrench or pliers
- Whistle
- Sterile bandages & gauze pads
- Adhesive tape
- Scissors, tweezes and needle
- Soap
- Moist towelettes
- Antiseptic spray, rubbing alcohol, eye wash, hydrogen peroxide
- Thermometer
- Latex gloves
- Petroleum jelly/lubricant
- Aspirin and non-aspirin pain reliever
- Antacid
- Anti-diarrhea medication & laxative
